A Typical Day in Preschool

Each day we start with free choice, the children settle by choosing an activity they feel comfortable with to support separation from parents and carers.

We have a phonic session and an adult-led activity running each day. A snack is offered during the session and the children also have access to the outside area.



Each child has a key worker who works closely with them and tracks their progress. This person is consistent with the child throughout their time in preschool.



As the children play and learn we will observe their progress, to feed into their learning journeys. These will be shared with you, as their parents regularly during parent consultation afternoons.

- We offer a safe, stimulating and caring environment for your child to develop and learn.
- Under the supervision of our highly qualified staff, children will be encouraged to learn through play and develop their independence and social skills.
- Each day will be carefully planned to involve elements of challenge, imagination and adventure.
